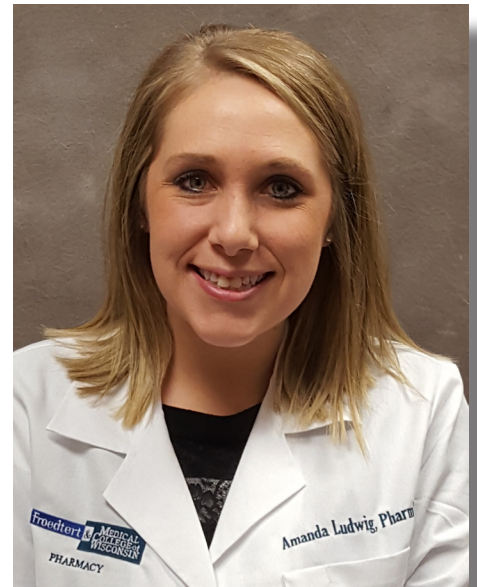




Ambulatory Care Practitioner Spotlight
