The Pharmacy Society of Wisconsin's Ambulatory Care Advisory Committee (ACAC) first met Dr. Abigail Moore two years ago. Dr. Moore is still an ambulatory care pharmacist within an ambulatory care clinic in Baraboo, Wisconsin. Since we last spoke to Dr. Moore, she has been promoted to the Pharmacy Manager and staffs the out-patient pharmacy within the clinic 2 days per week and splits her time the other 3 days a week between maintaining a smoking cessation ambulatory care practice and managerial responsibilities. Dr. Moore still works under the collaborative practice agreement



which allows her to prescribe all FDA-approved treatment options for smoking cessation, as well as order any labs or other necessary tests when clinically indicated. She has been focusing on smoking cessation services, becoming nationally certified as a tobacco treatment specialist and prior to COVID she was hosting a monthly quit smoking group with a physician's assistant and a nurse within the health department. She is able to accept referrals from providers as well as allows patient to self-refer themselves for her services. To continue to grow her clinical services at the clinic, Dr. Moore has become CDCES certified with plans to expand her ambulatory care practice into diabetes care. Since COVID, Dr. Moore and her staff have been very involved in COVID swabbing, flu vaccinations, and administering COVID vaccines in addition to normal responsibilities. Dr. Moore continues to move the needle for ambulatory care pharmacists in a combined retail/clinic setting forward! Dr. Moore and her team continue to help patients in every way possible and are persevering through the pandemic! Keep up the dedicated work Dr. Moore!
